

Public Hearing of the Town of Poland on Local Law #1 for 2018 - Changing Grievance Day Within the Town of Poland

A public hearing was held on Tuesday, March 13, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. in the Town Hall at 3593 Church Street, Kennedy, New York.

Supervisor Snow opened the Public Hearing at 7:02 p.m. with the Pledge to the flag. In attendance were Supervisor Kelly Snow, Councilman Corey Swanson, Councilman Stevan Hatfield, Councilman Norman Gustafson and Councilman Terry Walker. Also present were Highway Superintendent Larry Mee, Assessor Heather Young-Deyell, Zoning Officer George Gustafson, Code Officer Alan Gustafson Legislator John Davis and Town residents Don Holt and Post-Journal stringer Rose Mary Carver.

Town Clerk Bonnita Wallace read aloud the Legal Notice:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Town Board of the Town of Poland will hold a public hearing at the Town Hall, Church Street, Kennedy, New York on the 13th day of March, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. regarding the adoption of Local Law to change Grievance Day from the fourth Tuesday of May to the first Tuesday in June.

Any Resident of the Town of Poland shall be entitled to be heard upon said proposed local law at such public hearing. A copy of the proposed local law is available for review at the Town of Poland Clerk's Office, Church Street, Kennedy, New York.

Supervisor Kelly Snow read aloud the Local Law #1 - 2018:

Town of Poland - Chautauqua County Local Law Number 1 For the Year 2018

A Local Law Setting Grievance Day Within the Town of Poland

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Poland as follows:

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Poland wishes to set a date for Grievance Day different than the fourth Tuesday of May as required by RPTL § 512(1), and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Poland, as the assessing unit, desires to change the date from the fourth Tuesday of May to the first Tuesday of June, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Poland as follows:

GRIEVANCE DAY

1. The Town Board of the Town of Poland, pursuant to RPTL § 512(1-a) hereby establishes the first Tuesday of June as the Grievance Day for the Board of Assessments to review complaints in relation to

assessments.

2. This Local law shall take effect on the date of filing with the Secretary of the State of New York in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
